**Evidence of Completion**

Req's #1-4: Acceptable evidence of completion is either a copy of the applicants official BSA advancement record or photo copies of completed training certification cards.

Req's #5: Acceptable evidence of completion would be a note (50 words or less) describing the service provided at what camp and dated completed. Signed by the Camp or Aquatics Director or Ranger.
