Great Lakes Field Service Council is now taking youth and adult applications for the 2017 National Jamboree. The National Jamboree is the premier scouting event that occurs every four years. Do not let this opportunity pass you by.

When you apply, you need to complete the on-line application on the National Jamboree registration site, www.summitbsa.org/events/jamboree/jamboree-registration, and submit Great Lakes Council paper application along with a \$250 deposit with the Great Lakes Field Service Council. Be sure to include your Registration Code (13 digit number, XXX-XXXXXX-XXX) from your on-line application.

Deposits can be made to hold your spot by setting up a My Scouting account and making your deposit with the Great Lakes Field Service Council.

What adventures can you expect to concur at the 2017 National Jamboree:

- 5 Miles of Zip Line And Challenge Courses
- 36 Miles of Mountain Bike Trails
- 13 Acres of Shooting Sports Ranges
- Whitewater Rafting, Kayaking, Canoeing, Sailing
- Rock Climbing and Repelling
- Skateboarding / BMX

Proposed dates are July 15-28, 2017. The contingent is presently planning on including a pre-Jamboree expedition with the Jamboree encampment being July 19-28, 2015. The Jamboree will be held at the Summit Bechtel Reserve, West Virginia.
