70% Kids to Camp Promotion FAQ's Boy Scout Resident Summer Camp 2018

Q: What determines how many boys are in my unit?

A: This is the number of boys registered in your unit. One of easiest ways to determine this can be found on your unit charter.

Q: What about new Boy Scouts or Webelos that join after our unit completed the recharter process?

A: If you add new Boy Scouts or Webelos to your unit after the recharter process, then they would need to be included in number of boys in your unit. The goal of this promotion is to get 70% of your boys to camp! For example, if your unit recharter shows 25 youth and you subsequently add 5 new Webelos for a new total of 30 youth members, to qualify for the *70% Kids to Camp* promotion you will need to bring 21 boys to camp. [30 boys total x 70%]

Q: What about if our unit does not know the number of Webelos that will attend summer camp?

A: You would then need to bring 70% of your current youth or 18 boys in the example above. [25 boys x 70%]

Q: If we think our unit qualifies and we expect a refund, do we still need to make our final camp payment?

A: Yes. All units need to adhere to the Boy Scout Resident Summer Camp payment schedule. Late fees will be applied for any payments made after the May 7th payment deadline. The unit's 70% Kids to Camp refund will be calculated during the unit's financial checkout at the end of their week at camp with the Camp Business Manager. Q: Do I need to bring my unit's Charter to camp?

A: That would be helpful! Each Camp Business Manager will have the current MCC Roster Reports to help determine a unit's membership.

Q: Does this promotion apply to an Out-of-Council Unit?

A: No. While we greatly appreciate units attending our camps from other councils, the focus of this promotion is to get more MCC Scouts to camp. We also do not have access to out-of-council unit membership data.

Q: If my Scouts have a Campership or Sibling Discount, can they also quality for the 70% *Kids to Camp* discounted camp fee?

A: Yes. We want to make sure your boys get the maximum benefit possible!
