Established in 2009 to recognize valuable service of an exceptional nature by a Scout to a religious institution, a school, community, or other entity. Only one Eagle Scout per year will be selected. A bronze pin can be worn on the Eagle Scout knot of the Scout uniform.

NESA Outstanding Eagle Scout Award (NOESA)

A prestigious recognition granted by the local council's NESA Committee to Eagle Scouts who have demonstrated outstanding achievement at the local, state, or regional level.

Distinguished Eagle Scout Award (DESA)

Established in 1969 to acknowledge Eagle Scouts who have received extraordinary national-level recognition, fame, or eminence within their field, and have a strong record of voluntary service to their community.
