National Council Members:

National Council Members shall serve as members of the regional committee and shall attend all regional committee meetings and participate in the proceedings thereof. The duly elected council president and council commissioner are automatically elected to serve as local council representatives to the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America during their terms of office.

In addition to those Field Service Council presidents and Field Service Council commissioners who are elected by the executive board of the corporation to serve as local council representatives during their term of office, additional National Council Representatives allotted to the corporation shall be selected from and by the executive board of the corporation.

In addition to the council president and council commissioner, each local council may elect one of its members as a member of the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America for every 5,000 traditional program youth members (i.e., Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Varsity Scouts and Venturers), or major portion (2,501 or more) thereof enrolled as of December 31 of the preceding year.*

Traditional membership for MCC, not inclusive of Exploring, as of 12/31/14 is 68,591. Michigan Crossroads Council may elect 14 National Council Members in addition to Council President and Council Commissioner for 2014.
