

2018 Vigil Honor Nomination

The Vigil Honor is unique. It is a high mark of distinction and recognition for Arrowmen who, by the reason of exceptional service and unselfish interest, have made distinguished contributions beyond the immediate responsibilities of their position. As such, it is the highest honor that an Order of the Arrow Lodge can bestow on its members. The Vigil Honor is not earned; it is given to honor someone for going above and beyond the description of his or her position in scouting, for the greater good of the boys. Under no circumstances should tenure in Scouting or the Order of the Arrow be considered as reason enough for a Vigil Honor recommendation. To be eligible for consideration for the Vigil Honor, an Arrowman must have been a Brotherhood member for at least two years as of the due date of this nomination form and a member in good standing of the Great Lakes FSC, Michigan Crossroads Council, BSA and the Noquet Lodge #29 (registered with dues paid, which will be verified)

A picture of the nominee is REQUIRED. To get a picture, check your phone, check your camera and/or go to social media.

Also, as a nominator, you will have the opportunity to talk about your nominee to the Vigil committee and make the case for their nomination, if you wish. You will have approximately 1 to 2 minutes before the committee so you will need to be short and concise. If there is more than one nomination for the same person, then only one nominator will appear before the committee.
