Campership & Sibling Discount Registration Information


When you make a summer camp registration for a Scout that: (1) has applied for an MCC Campership, or (2) qualifies for the MCC Sibling Discount, (cannot be awarded both) you will see the following 2 check boxes at the bottom of the youth participant registration screen:

Campership - MCC	Are you applying for "Campership - MCC"?
Sibling Discount	Are you applying for "Sibling Discount"?

If the youth registrant has applied for an <u>MCC Campership</u>, please: (1) put a check in the box that precedes *"Are you applying for a "Campership – MCC"?*, <u>and</u> (2) in the *"Amount Requested"* box, enter the amount of the Campership that was <u>applied</u> for. The applied-for amount of a Campership cannot exceed 50% of the camp fee.



If the youth registrant qualifies for the <u>Sibling Discount</u>, please: (1) put a check in the box that precedes *"Are you applying for "Sibling Discount"?*, <u>and</u> (2) in the *"Amount Requested"* box, enter the amount of \$25. For siblings attending Boy Scout Resident Camp, the 1st sibling pays the regular camp fee, and each subsequent sibling is eligible to receive the \$25 Sibling Discount. Siblings do not need to attend the same session or the same Boy Scout Resident Camp.



If this information was not completed when the youth participant was initially registered, the unit's registration contact can go back into the unit's registration and can edit a participant, and complete this information up to midnight of the Friday before the unit arrives at summer camp.
