

Boy Scout offers helping hand to DeZwaan windmill

Aisa Crawford is the only Dutch-certified miller in the United States and she operates the DeZwaan windmill located at the Windmill Island Gardens in Holland Michigan. It is a strenuous job where during Tulip Time, she was hand bagging anywhere from 250 to 450 pounds of wheat a day. In a year, that number grows to between 10,000 and 12,000 pounds. Michigan Scout is top popcorn seller in the nation, breaks record

He's done it again - but this time, it's bigger. Boy Scout Mason Schlafer, 11, of Norton Shores, is the top seller in the nation and has broken a national record for the Boy Scouts of America's popcorn sales. He sold more than \$57,000-worth of popcorn. In 2016, Schlafer sold more than \$20,000-worth, which made him the top seller in the Boy Scouts of America Central Region. It was enough to fund the purchase of 10 years' worth of Pinewood Derby trophies for Troop 1053. That broke the previous regional, 13-state popcorn sales record of \$18,730. His motivation this year was to purchase tents and provide camp scholarships for his troop.
