MCC Camp App Guide

Overview: Michigan Crossroads Council has developed "Camp Apps" for all of its camps. The Apps are designed to be used by unit leaders attending events at camp to access camp events, weather, and maps, as well as provide feedback on camp facilities and staff. The Apps contain a notification mechanism that allows camp staff to push out notification to all Camp App users about emergencies (weather, etc.).

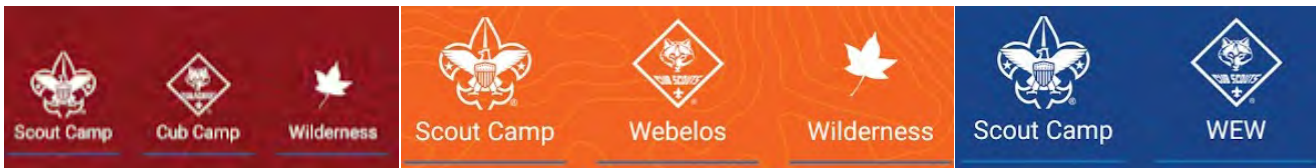

Notable Features and Usage Notes

Scout Camp, Cub Camp, Webelos, WEW/Wilderness

Each App starts with icons for the specific programs (Scouts BSA Summer Camp, Cub Scout camp, etc.) that are offered at that camp. If you are attending a summer program, tap the icon of your program to get program-specific details such as leaders guides, menus and schedules.



Documents

The Camp Apps provide a method for accessing and/or downloading maps, forms and various schedules/documents in a PDF format.



TIP: If you hit the down arrow in the upper right corner of a PDF, you can




download it directly to your device. You can then access it in your phone's download/documents section. Useful for areas where Internet connectivity is limited.

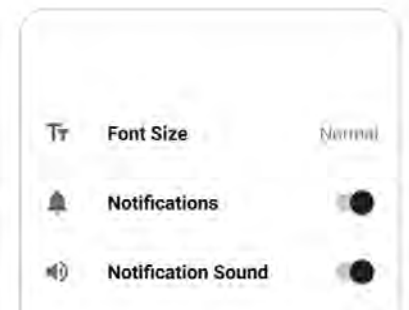


Push Notifications

A great feature of the Camp Apps is that camp staff will be able to send notifications to all Camp App users at their site. These messages can be emergency warnings about weather or emergencies. You do not need to have the Camp App open to receive these messages; they will appear at the top of your screen with your other message icons.

 **TIP:** During the summer when not physically at camp, you should turn OFF notifications (under **My Profile** → **Settings**) until you are on onsite.

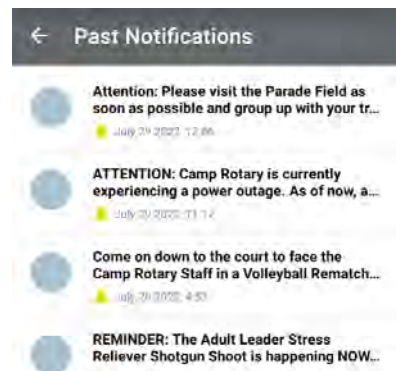
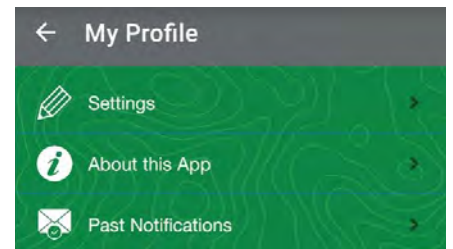
You can view previous notifications under **My Profile**. You will see all notifications that have been sent since you first



My Profile

Settings allows you to turn off/on Notifications and/or Notification Sounds. You can also adjust the font size. See note on next page about Push Notifications.

Past Notifications will show any Push Notifications that have been sent since installing the Camp App. See Push Notifications on next page for more info.



Weather

The **Weather** menu item provides a quick links to the weekly forecast .

The Resources section has other camp and council specific links that you may find helpful. Links to upcoming events, facility rental, incident reporting tool, camp facebook and other tools can be found here. You can even access the registration link to download your camp reports, link to Scoutbook to upload, and then purchase your awards by importing your Scoutbook CSV to the MCC Online Shop!

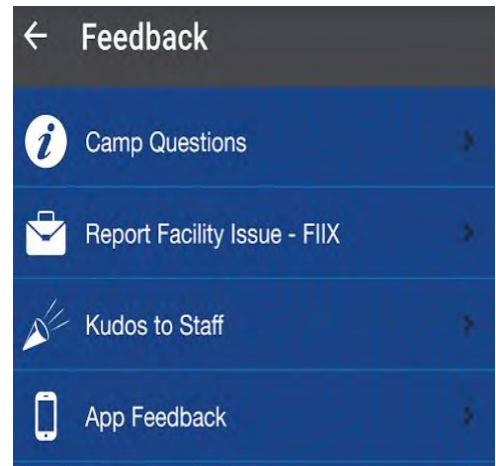
Feedback

Under the **Feedback** section of the App can be found forms and links to various methods for providing instant feedback.

Report Facility Issue—FIIX: Can be used to alert the Camp Ranger to an issue with a campsite or other camp location. For emergencies, please contact the camp office directly.

Kudos to Staff: Can be used to let camp directors know of camp staff members that are going above and beyond their normal duties.

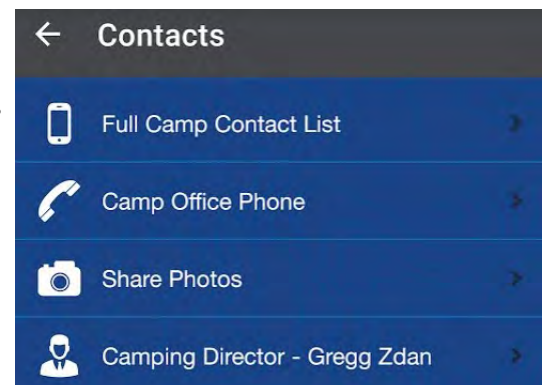
App Feedback: Method for letting MCC know of any issues or wish-list items specifically with the Camp App itself. Note that direct technical support cannot be provided on the App.



Camp Contacts

Email and/or phone contact information for various staff can be accessed and used from the App.

Click on the person you would like to contact, and then click the Phone and/or email address to open your device's default application for that action.



Internet connectivity is required to access the functions of the Camp Apps. Camp Staff is unable to provide technical support on the App.

The Camp App is provided as a courtesy to our units attending Scouts BSA camps. Feedback on features can be provided via the App Feedback form in the App, but it will not provide individual or immediate technical support. As always, an App never replaces direct one-on-one communication. Reach out to your Camp Staff – they don't bite.
