SUMMARY OF SCHOLARSHIP

The Building Connections Scholarship is a \$1,000 a year, renewable scholarship, for a maximum of four years \$4,000) to attend an accredited college, trade school, or university with a focus on building construction and design in some capacity. Applicants must be qualified and worthy graduating high school seniors or between the ages of 17-20 years of age Selection will be made by a designated committee and will be announced at the annual Building Connections Event, normally held in September each year. The Scholarship recipient may apply to have the scholarship renewed provided the renewal criterion is met.

REQUIREMENTS

All Applicants for Building Connections Scholarship Must:

- Be a Scout, Venture or Exploring post member and be a currently registered and an active member of the Michigan Crossroads Council, Boy Scouts of America.
- Be a graduating High School Senior and hold a minimum of a 3.0 cumulative grade point average or be between the ages of 17-20 years of age.
- Have the application submitted by August 1. Can be mailed or submitted electronically. If mailing use sufficient postage. Submissions should be sent to Building Connections Scholarship Committee.
- 4. Provide a **High School Transcript showing ACT/SAT scores** and class ranking, if available.
- Submit proof of College acceptance in a program accredited for construction or design.

- 6. Attend, in uniform, (or send a representative) the Building Connections event in September (typically 3rd Thursday)
- Provide an essay by the applicant entitled, "How I will make a
 positive impact on society through my career in construction or
 design?" (approx. 250 to 300 words).
- 8. Provide three recommendation letters; one must be from your Scoutmaster, Exploring or Venturing Advisor (including a case statement of need), and two others from other than family members. If using a reference from a school related person, use only one. Job, religion, or personal are acceptable.

Renewal requirements:

documented progress toward a degree in a construction or design related field. 3.0 cumulative grade point average, continuing need

- Complete the application personally.
