


WHAT IS THE CAMPMASTER PROGRAM



HOW DO YOU APPLY **TO BE A CAMPMASTER?**

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Be a registered Scouter at least 21 years of age.
- 2. Have Scouting leadership experience. Other leadship experience will be considered as well.
- Be familiar with the operation of Scouting units (Pack, Troop, Crew, Post) as well as the aims and methods of Scouting.
- 4. Have current Youth Protection Training.
- 5. Have a minimum of curent First Aid/ CPR/AED training.
- 6. Be willing to serve two (2) weekends per year as a Campmaster.
- 7. While serving as Campmaster, be willing to stay on site in the provided housing for the duration of the weekend, not have any other assigned duties.
- 8. Fill out and submit the required DHHS Form: https://bit.ly/3IzSCH3.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

- 1. Fill out the Campmaster application form.
- 2. Provide evidence of completed trainings and application to Campmaster.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

- 1. Campmaster Chief and Asstistant Chief will review applications and recommend individuals to the Program Committee.
- 2. The committee will evaluate each candidate in areas such as Scouting knowledge, Scouting experience, property specific experience, customer service skills, perceived ability to act in an emergency, ect.
- 3. If the candidate is endorsed by the program committee, they will be notified by the Campmaster Chief and added to the schedule. Training will occur annually, or as needed, for new Campmasters.
