# A Contingent from your Troop or Crew can Participate in a Jamboree or Stay at an International Scout Center in Another Country

## **International Committee, Michigan Crossroads Council BSA**

July 1, 2023, update

The fee to participate in a jamboree in another country or stay at an international Scout Center is low enough that, even adding airfare, the total cost per person of an overseas trip is similar to the cost of participating in the BSA National Jamboree or a Philmont trip. You can form a contingent from one troop or crew or from a group of neighboring troop(s) and crew(s). The MCC International Committee will be glad to help you in your planning. Send an email message to <a href="mailto:international@michiganscouting.org">international@michiganscouting.org</a> It is best to start planning a trip to a jamboree in another country at least a year before the jamboree takes place, so now is the time to begin planning a trip to a summer 2024 jamboree.

JAMBOREES IN OTHER COUNTRIES - The BSA is a member of the World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM). Many WOSM-affiliated National Scout Organizations (NSOs) open their jamborees to contingents from other countries. Most of these jamborees are a week to a week and a half long. That allows a BSA contingent to include time on their trip for sightseeing. There are very few BSA contingents at these jamborees. A BSA contingent can often arrange to pair with a Scout group from the host country that is participating in the same jamboree, share a campsite with them, and borrow group equipment such as tents, stoves, and cooking equipment from them. That provides the BSA contingent with a unique experience, and they don't need to bring group gear. Jamboree websites often state an age range for participants. However, international participants a little older than a stated maximum age might be acceptable. According to BSA's Age-Appropriate Guidelines for Camping (https://filestore.scouting.org/filestore/HealthSafety/pdf/680-686.pdf) BSA youth must be at least 12 years old to participate in jamborees.

**INTERNATIONAL SCOUT CENTERS** - An International Scout Center will typically have Scout groups from a number of different countries in camp at any time and an international staff. Many of them offer opportunities for in-camp activities and nearby outdoor expeditions and sightseeing and have both tent campsites and rooms with bunks and mattresses. With an International Scout Center, you are not constrained by the dates of a jamboree. You can typically make a reservation for whatever dates and time period you desire.

**CONSIDER CANADA** - The transportation cost to a Scouts Canada event is much lower than it is to Europe, and Scouts under 19 traveling to Canada as a group by land can use birth certificates in place of passports. Michigan troops have had great experiences spending weeks at Scouts Canada's Haliburton Scout Reserve in northern Ontario - https://www.scouts.ca/camps/haliburton-scout-reserve.html - and at jamborees in Canada.

For members of Scouts Canada, the early registration fee is Cdn \$551.25 which currently equals about U.S. \$410 and the Offer of Service fee is Cdn \$199.50 which currently equals about U.S. \$150. The website states: "Check back soon for information on registering international Patrols and Offers of Service for PJ 2024!" Contingents from a Michigan troop participated in the 2015 and 2019 Pacific Jamborees and had a great time.
