


This presentation is about the recharter process and resources available to Commissioners and unit leaders this recharter season.



This year will be **similar to last year**, the **biggest difference** that we know of so far is that those **members who join after August 1** will be noted as prepaid in the recharter system and **the unit will not have to collect National and MCC fees for their continued membership**, the unit is simply confirming that those members are on their roster.

- They will be noted with a 0 dollar amount due in the recharter roster.

Review of the major goals for the recharter season:


- Unit charters completed <u>and pre-posted or posted by December 20, 2023.</u>
- All applications for new youth and adult members be handled electronically. Including unit to unit transfers and adult leader position changes.
- All adult YPT current through March 1, 2024.
- No attached paperwork to the recharter.
 In order to achieve these goals a timeline has been set-up with four different phases.

Key Dates:

First week of October - Internet recharter system opens and unit recharter champions should be logging in to the system

November 15 or November Roundtable - unit recharters submitted and approved by the unit Key 3

December 20 - Units posted or pre-posted.



Much of the **success of the recharter season** is based on preparation in these first months of the recharter season.

The importance of early initial preparation is so that when unit leaders are busy with **initial program kick-offs**, **new membership**, **and fundraising like popcorn**, **the foundation for charter renewal** has already taken place




<u>UNIT KEY 3 and Commissioner meet to work out a game plan for</u> recharter


- Be sure to enter the meeting as a simple contact or a detailed assessment in Commissioner Tools!



Review unit **YPT Aging report**, Encourage leaders whose YPT expires before March 1 2024 to update their YPT now.




YPT Aging report which can be easily accessed on the new unit dashboard.




CONTINUE TO ENCOURAGE UNITS TO USE ON-LINE APPLICATIONS for Youth and Adults.


- The system is easy to use and there are tutorials available at the internet-recharter page on the MCC website.
- Typically new applicants show up by the next morning once the youth applications are approved by unit leadership or the adult applications are approved by the COR or COR delegate.



Encourage unit leaders to **update their unit pin and to make sure** that they turn-on the use of on-line applications.




Review QR Code and unit URL location in Invitation Manager



REVIEW UNITS FINANCIAL RESOURCES TO PAY FOR RECHARTER


- Will **Popcorn or other fundraisers** be needed to assist with funding recharter or other unit activities?
- Will financial aid be needed for some scouts to reregister?



USE POSITION MANAGER TO CORRECT ALL ADULT POSITIONS, INCLUDING COR DELEGATE AND KEY 3 DELEGATE ROLES




- Review Position Manager for Registered Positions and Functional Roles
- Determine who the unit recharter champion will be:
 - Encourage the unit leadership to establish a unit recharter champion who will lead the recharter effort and be the person trained to manage the recharter process.
 - Make sure that the unit recharter champion is either a key 3 member or Key 3 delegate in the unit.
 - Later in the season The recharter champion will review recharter training materials when available.



ANNUAL CHARTER AGREEMENT



Recharter Training in terms of unit recharter champion.



This phase is when the recharter system opens, typically in the first few days of October



Please encourage unit recharter champion to login to the recharter system in the first week to make sure that they can access the system, check the roster for completeness, and make note of any missing YPT or CBC forms for adult leaders.



We want to make sure that if there are missing members, that there are electronic applications submitted for those members. And if there are any missing CBC forms or YPT certificates, that they are submitted to their District Professional to make sure that the forms are updated in the registration system.



About the time of the November Roundtable, units should be wrapping up the recharter process by submitting their recharter and making an on-line electronic payment, either by the ACH system or by credit card.

- The exception to this is if the unit is receiving some form of financial aid, in which case, payment may need to be made to an MCC office.



After the charter has been submitted, we want to make sure that the recharter is approved by one of the Key 3 or one of the delegates.




DO YOUR DUTY

In the Do Your Duty phase, our council receives the recharter.



If there is no attached paperwork and payment is made on-line, the charter should quickly pre-post and then post. If there is attached paperwork, or financial aid involved, the council office will then review the recharter and advise of any defects found.




It is also a good practice to review the unit roster for completeness after the unit posts to make sure that the registered roster is complete.



CELEBRATE

This is time to celebrate the completion the recharter season by printing out and distributing the membership cards and the unit recharter certificate.



The new charter certificate can also be easily accessed through the new unit dashboard. This should be celebrated as another year of Scouting activities.


