



Position Description

Jamboree Scoutmaster

Objective: To lead a troop of scouts and adults to the 2026 Jamboree and provide the best program possible, while ensuring unit, council, and National Scouting standards are maintained

Responsible to: MCC Jamboree Committee Chairman

Tenure: Summer 2025 through fall 2026

Responsibilities:

- Manage and oversee all operations within a contingent provisional Scout troop of 36 scouts and 4 adult leaders, before and during the 2026 National Jamboree. Be personally responsible for the health, safety, and morale of the contingent troop.
- Ensure unit utilizes the Patrol Method.
- Direct supervisor and advisor to Jamboree Troop Senior Patrol Leader.
- Promote the 2026 Jamboree to youth within your unit, district, and council.
- Be an active member of the MCC Jamboree Committee including membership on a subcommittee to support the readiness of the contingent.
- Attend meetings of council contingent troop leadership.
- Ensure that registrations, Jamboree fees, Health and Medical records, and other Jamboree materials for the youth and leaders of your contingent troop are received by the National and Michigan Crossroads Council as required by the deadlines set forth by the National and MCC Jamboree committees.
- Primary responsibility for unit communications.
- Plan, organize, and preside over contingent troop meetings of youth and parents/guardians at least once per month prior to the Jamboree.
- With your troop, promote and attend all council contingent Jamboree team building and shakedown campouts prior to Jamboree.
- Manage youth leadership selection within your unit.
- While at the Jamboree, act as the primary leader when interfacing with parents/guardians, Jamboree Staff, Commissioners, and Medical personnel.

Requirements:

- Must have a current BSA membership with a Boy Scout troop or Varsity Scout team.
- Be at least 21 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree (July 22, 2026)
- Be a current or previous Scoutmaster or Varsity Coach within the Michigan Crossroads Council.
- Completed This is Scouting Training.
- Completed Fast Start Training.
- Completed Scoutmaster or Varsity Scout Coach Leader-Specific Training.
- Completed Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills.
- Completed Youth Protection Training within one year of the first day of the Jamboree (July 22, 2026).
- Completed Hazardous Weather Training.
- Be able to serve as a role model of physical fitness.
- Have participated in the pre-jamboree training experience.

- Have filed a Jamboree Personal Health and Medical record with the council jamboree committee before the pre-jamboree training.
- Be approved by the local council.
- Submit all registration fees per the local council's payment schedule.
- Attend, with your home-unit, a Michigan Crossroads Council summer-Encampment session at least once prior to 2026 Jamboree.
- Participate in, with your home-unit, the annual Popcorn sale.
- Prefer to have Led or co-led at least one, preferably multiple, large unit high adventure trips
