Advanced Training Group Application

BSA members may find the cost of certain training opportunities to be a financial burden. Financial assistance is available through several sources. Be sure to check for support from your unit, chartered organization, or employer first. If this is unsuccessful or insufficient, you are invited to submit the following application.

Eligibility

Scholarship funds from the Advanced Training Group are available to any qualified **Adult** applicant from the Michigan Crossroads Council. To be eligible, all of the following criteria must be met by the applicant:

- Registered as a BSA Adult member in the Michigan Crossroads Council and in good standing for at least 30 days prior to completing the application.
- Applications must be fully trained in their primary registered positions.
- Be one of the following:
 - o NYLT staff member serving an NYLT course hosted by Michigan Crossroads Council.
 - Wood Badge course hosted within Michigan Crossroads Council, or Wood Badge staff member serving a Wood Badge course hosted by Michigan Crossroads Council.
 - Powder Horn course hosted within Michigan Crossroads Council, or Powder Horn staff member serving a Powder Horn course hosted by Michigan Crossroads Council.
 - Sea Badge course hosted within Michigan Crossroads Council, or Sea Badge staff member serving a Sea Badge course hosted by Michigan Crossroads Council.

Scholarship Details

Scholarships may be awarded in any amount but will not exceed half the fee for the course you are attending. If you are applying for assistance for multiple training opportunities, you must submit a separate application for each course you are attending.

In keeping with the philosophy of "pay your own way," each applicant should pay a portion of the fee. The applicant's family, unit, chartering organization, or employer might also contribute to the cost of training.

Application Procedure

- Applications must be received no later than 30 days prior to the start of the course you are attending.
- Applications will not be considered before the applicant registers for the course and submits any required deposit.

- Applicants are notified of the decision within 3 days of receiving the application. Notification is sent to the email address provided on the application.
