ONE YEAR - Standardize maintenance processes across all camps and offices. This includes organizing SharePoint for easier access to forms and schedules, and creating clear, consistent procedures for routine and emergency tasks. The maintenance team will be trained on the new system and stay connected through regular communication. By the end of the year, everyone will be using the same tools and processes to work more efficiently together.

THREE YEAR - Over the next three years, we will build a fully integrated and proactive maintenance system across all camps and offices. This includes refining processes, using data to guide preventive maintenance, and improving tools for tracking and planning work. The maintenance team will continue to grow through training and shared standards, creating a consistent, efficient approach across all locations. At the same time, we will streamline food service operations across camps by aligning practices and leveraging the best possible acquisition pricing through our food vendors. By year three, we'll shift from reactive fixes to long-term planning and prevention, while also improving cost efficiency and consistency in food service delivery.

FIVE YEAR - I aim to advance into a Director of Camping Services role within a 100- or 200-level council. I will build on my experience in camp operations, facilities and fleet management, food service, budgeting, and regulatory compliance. By consistently improving program quality, managing successful summer seasons, and strengthening partnerships with both the national office and state licensing agencies, I will position myself as a strong leader ready to take on broader responsibilities at a higher level.
