

Position Description

Jamboree 3rd Assistant Scoutmaster

Objective: To support the Jamboree Contingent Scoutmaster in leading a troop of scouts to the 2026 Jamboree and provide the best program possible, while ensuring unit, council, and National standards are maintained.

Responsible to: Jamboree Scoutmaster

Tenure: Summer 2025 through fall 2026

Responsibilities:

- Support all operations within a contingent provisional Scout troop of 36 scouts and 4 leaders, before and during the 2026 National Jamboree.
- Work with the Scoutmaster to ensure unit utilizes the Patrol Method.
- Direct supervisor and advisor to Jamboree Troop Scribe/Media Master.
- Promote the 2026 Jamboree to youth within your unit, district, and council.
- Direct supervisor and advisor to Jamboree Troop Hometown News Correspondents.
- Responsible for troop first aid. Notify Jamboree Troop Scoutmaster and Subcamp Medical officer of serious cases.
- Maintain general morale of youth in the troop. Coordinate distribution of mail and other communications.
- With your troop, promote and attend all council contingent Jamboree shakedown campouts prior to Jamboree.
- Assist the Jamboree Scoutmaster in the youth leadership selection process within your unit.

Requirements:

- Must have a current BSA membership with a Boy Scout troop or Venture Crew.
- Be at least 18 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree (July 22, 2026)
- Be currently serving in any leadership position within a Boy Scout troop or Varsity Scout team.
- Completed This is Scouting Training.
- Completed Fast Start Training.
- Completed Scoutmaster or Varsity Scout Coach Leader-Specific Training.
- Completed Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills.
- Completed Youth Protection Training within one year of the last day of the Jamboree. (July 22, 2026)
- Completed Hazardous Weather Training.
- Be able to serve as a role model of physical fitness.
- Have participated in the pre-jamboree training experience.
- Have filed a Jamboree Personal Health and Medical record with the council jamboree committee before the pre-jamboree training.
- Be approved by the local council.
- Submit all registration fees per the local council's payment schedule.
