Application for Venturers, Sea Scouts, and Adult Leaders

Requirements:

- Become trained in Safe Swim Defense and Safety Afloat
- 2. Earn both Aquatics Supervision
 - A. Swimming and Water Rescue
 - B. Paddle Craft Safety (Basic)
- Become Certified in First Aid and CPR/AED (American Red Cross or Equivalent)
- 4. Complete one of the following Aquatic Awards
 - A. Kayaking
 - B. Mile Swim
 - C. Snorkeling
 - D. Scuba
 - E. Boardsailing
 - F. Stand Up Paddleboarding
 - G. Whitewater Rafting
- 5. Provide four hours of Service at a Michigan Crossroads Council Waterfront

Evidence of Completion:

Req's #1-4: Acceptable evidence of completion is either a copy of the applicants official BSA advancement record or photocopies of completed training certification cards.

Req's #5: Acceptable evidence of completion would be a note (50 words or less) describing the service provided at what camp and dated completed. Signed by the Camp or Aquatics Director or Ranger.
