

Klarna payments with Online Registration (and Renewals)

A person paying for membership in Scouting America can choose to pay with a Credit Card or select Klarna and may pay their payment in 4 equal installments over six weeks.


The user completes the application, goes to the payment screen, reviews the fees, enters a discount code if applicable, and verifies the Scout Life Magazine setting is correct.



The user will scroll down to the payment Details section, select "Klarna Payment," and see that there are two options. Next, you click "Place Order", which takes you to the Klarna site.




You would choose the "4 payments" option and continue.



You will be asked to fill in all the basic credit card details. After receiving a confirmation of payment, you will make the first payment today.

There are several types of Credit Cards that Klarna does not accept to open an account. They will not take Chase Credit Cards, American Express, Capital One, or any prepaid card.



Once you click on "Pay with Klarna," you will return to the Scouting America Receipt, which will show you have paid in full. You are all paid up with Scouting but will still owe Klarna for the remaining 3 payments.
