#### No Changes

Families will follow the same process as last season to apply for financial assistance; but may only apply for one scholarship opportunity per scout



#### Available All Season

Scholarship process is available throughout the entire 2026 season; March 15th is the preferred submission date



#### Open to MCC Scouts

Scholarship applications are open to all registered Scouts BSA youth in the Michigan Crossroads Council for attendance at an MCC Camp



#### Easy to Use

#### Covers up to 50%


Scholarships can be awarded in amounts up to half of the 2026 Summer Camp fee

Make sure to check out the camp summer registration pages to view all our campsponsored provisional sessions, where the camp will provide the leadership for your Scouts to attend!











